## **Fellowship Quick Guide**

This is a short guide for those considering Fellowship in ASMIRT.

- 1. A Fellow of the Australian Society of Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy is a unique **individual** journey within a maximum five-year period.
- 2. A Fellow must have been a financial voting member for the previous five years prior AND to submission of their Fellowship application.
- 3. A candidate must <u>demonstrate a wide breadth of knowledge and work</u> towards at least 180 points.
- 4. Duplicated material is not able to be accepted. For example, points for the same or similar paper cannot be claimed for both publication and presentation.
- 5. A Mentor is highly recommended and regarded as a must have.
- 6. To start with look at the precis example below and fill it in as it applies to your journey.

Any activity which does not attain 50% of the available points for that activity would be deemed to have been completed at an unacceptable level for Fellowship and would therefore be ineligible for points accumulation.

- 7. It is mandatory that a submission must contain at least one paper presentation at ASMIRT and at least one peer reviewed article published in the Journal of Medical Radiation Sciences or peer reviewed journal of equivalent standing.
- 8. Contact the Fellowship Warden for further advice and to be listed as a candidate if you choose to pursue Fellowship.
- 9. Keep records of all activity in the required format found in the Fellowship Guidelines which can be obtained from ASMIRT or the Fellowship Warden.
- 10. All successful candidates must submit a bound book of their work to ASMIRT. The CASMIRT Board will hold one copy of each successful Fellowship submission.
