Membership class	Eligibility criteria	Membership rights
Voting Member	A Voting Member must comply with the requirements set out in constitution rule 4.2; and (a) satisfy one of the following requirements: (i) hold a recognised relevant qualification in Medical Radiation Science; or (ii) be undertaking a supervised practice program in Medical Radiation Science.	A Voting Member has the right to receive notices of, attend and be heard at general meetings of members; and (a) exercise one vote: (i) on a Show of Preference at a meeting of members; (ii) on a poll at a meeting of members; and (iii) when voting upon a resolution to be determined without a meeting under rule 6.1.1.
Non-Voting Member	A Non-Voting Member must comply with the requirements set out in constitution rule 4.2; and (a) satisfy one or more of the following requirements: (i) be undertaking training towards a recognised relevant qualification in Medical Radiation Science; (ii) not hold a recognised relevant qualification in Medical Radiation Science and be determined to be sufficiently connected to Medical Radiation Science or its application; or (iii) have otherwise made a distinguished contribution to the Medical Radiation Science profession.	A Non-Voting Member has the right to receive notices of, attend and be heard at general meetings of members. A Non-Voting Member does not have the right to exercise a vote.
